The Christian Ministries course of study is designed to train young men and women to serve in the church in a secondary capacity under the leadership of a man of God. They will be well-equipped to serve in a variety of capacities within any ministry of the local church including the Sunday school, youth ministry, music ministry, church office, et al.

Christian Ministries majors will take all general courses as listed below. In addition, the registrar will place them in a rotation of study and practical training each semester alongside majors in Theology, Missions, Education, or Music. Their degree, then, does not represent any one of these majors, but rather a sampling of coursework and practical training from any two or more of these.
